### DEOMI RELEASES 2014 HOLOCAUST NATIONAL DAYS OF REMEMBRANCE POSTER

PATRICK AIR FORCE BASE, Fla. – In observance of the Holocaust Days of Remembrance, observed each year during the week of Remembrance that runs from the Sunday before Holocaust Remembrance Day (*Yom Hashoah*) through the following Sunday, the Defense Equal Opportunity Management Institute (DEOMI), proudly announces original artwork available for download from DEOMI's public website, [www.deomi.org](http://www.deomi.org).

This year, the Holocaust Days of Remembrance week will be observed from April 27 – May 4, 2014. Holocaust Remembrance Day is Monday, April 28, 2014. The United States Congress established the Days of Remembrance as our nation's annual commemoration of the victims of the Holocaust and created the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum, <http://www.ushmm.org>, as a permanent, living memorial to those victims. The Museum designated "*Confronting the Holocaust: American Responses*" as the theme for the 2014 observance.


