3. Closed Business:

Matt Porter and Greg Schnulo, original members of the 121<sup>st</sup> LPC, are leaving the council effective this month. A recommendation for a “three-day off” award will be given to their supervisors, and a *Certificate of Appreciation for Distinguished Service*, for their immense contribution, and many years served will be presented to them at a meeting deemed appropriate by the council.

4. Open Business:

Brig Gen Botchie has brought to the attention of the LPC, an upcoming civilian pay shortfall reported to him by the Chief of the Financial Analysis Division (Budget). The following matters were discussed by the council, and have determined that more information is required from the Finance Comptroller, Lt Col Folk, before any final decisions can be made:

- Hiring with-in the wing funding is available, but hiring from outside the unit will only happen when funding is available.
- Releasing temporary technicians at the earliest date possible, so LWOP for permanent technicians may not become an issue.
- Volunteer LWOP commitment. Ex: LWOP: Thurs and Fri – Drill plus two comp days.
- Review leave balance of retiring technicians: Determine their plans for selling leave; Supplement their leave with AT days, so as not to suffer un-forecasted costs.

5. Action items:

- Brig Gen Botchie will meet with Lt Col Folk to accumulate dollar number savings on the items listed above, so the council can make an educated decision that will be in the best interest of the full-time work force.
- Each Group Commander will interview forecasted retirees for leave plans.
