SUBJECT: LPC Meeting Minutes for May, 2007

4. Old Business

A. Condensed Work Week Schedule: There has been no answer on the proposal which requested a condensed work week schedule. Leimenstoll has tried contacting Dan Roche. This needs to be resolved before everyone deploys.

B. Do we have meetings during upcoming deployment? The charter would allow the meetings even if the quorum was not met; however, they wouldn't be allowed to vote. Brent Leimenstoll said he would contact members that were still here to find out if they wanted to hold any meetings during the deployment.

C. The following items were not discussed at this meeting and still remain open:

1. 180-06-16 19 Dec 06 **LM Training – Danko**

Mike Danko still needs the newer training primarily in the IBB process.

Status: Open.

2. 03 Apr 07 **New Co-chair Needed – Leimenstoll**

Brent Leimenstoll stated that his management co-chair responsibilities ends in June. He was looking for a new person to take over as the co-chair. Michael Masiker volunteered to be the interim co-chair until William Giezie returns in two months. In June, the new co-chair needs to be decided.

Status: Open.

6. New Business

A. LPC7 Cross-Utilization Training (CUT): Copic says there is nothing in the current AFI 21-101 which states that personnel have to hold a 7 level in order to be in CUT-training (used to be in the superseded version of AFI 21-101). Copic said that in the past, management's stance was that if they changed career fields, they weren't allowed to stay CUT-trained. He has lost several important members of his Hydrazine team because of this (i.e. Chandler, Stier, Kimple, Maynard). He stated that it is easy for him to maintain his CUT-trained personnel and that they shouldn't be taken off just because of upgrade training because this leads to him to not have enough people when we go on deployments (Danko asked if they were short at any other time but Copic confirmed that it was only during deployments). Why go back to past practice?

1. Reagan stated that it should depend on the task if they would be allowed to CUT-train. He stated that it should be up to the supervisor and it shouldn't interfere with upgrade training.
2. Jones stated that Chandler wouldn't be allowed to CUT-train right now because it would conflict with his upgrade training.
3. It was decided to rewrite LPC7 to update it with the current information from AFI 21-101 where 7 level training is not a deciding factor on whether you could be CUT-trained. It would be up to the supervisor to decide; but, encouraged. Also, a key factor for allowing CUT-training would be IF it didn't interfere with upgrade training. Lastly, LPC7 would state CUT-training be "voluntary" and not "mandatory." It was also agreed that if someone is an expediter or in MOC, they would not be expected to CUT-train.

4. Look for a revision in August.

James Reagan moved to revisit the LPC7 issue in August.

Todd Copic seconded the motion.

B. The 180th LPC will reconvene TENTATIVELY on June 12, 2007 at 1400hrs in the Wing Commander's Conference Room.
