5. Old Business

A. Repairing Smoke Shacks – the board is having a special meeting to discuss the situation with the smoke shacks. They are not up to current code and need replaced. Jones attended the meeting to stress that she thought it didn't make sense to have to tear down the current buildings. She asked if anyone had just asked if it was okay to keep them. Perlaky read the law to her. Dohrmann said that the CBA is in compliance right now because there are shelters on base but that they are not IAW state law and that Bartman has to decide to follow the law or not.

a. Types of smoke shelters we can purchase:

Lipper – looked up various types of pre-made buildings that the unit could buy. She found that many were expensive. Best price she found was an 8-sided gazebo that would run \$2500 – 3500. We could go to Lowes and buy some plywood to put up on 2 sides of the gazebo. They could have screens if we paid \$700 extra. Giezie said the gazebos would look nice on base. Haas said we didn't need the screens due to the cost. Dohrmann said that if we built them – we deal with comp time issues and what if someone gets hurt while building these. He suggested having Red Horse come in to build them under AT days. Giezie said he could always ask if 12 guys wanted to come over for 2 weeks to build them.

Masiker – had the LPC go to www.buckeyebarns.com and looked at the smoking shelters offered at this site. They would only cost \$995 and have the walls built on them. Plus, they come assembled. They have a local business in Maumee, Ohio. The LPC members agreed that this was the better choice. Lipper said she would have contracting get a quote to have them priced out. Then, she would ask the co-chairs if they wanted to take the quote to Bartman or if they wanted her to take the quote to Bartman. LPC wants Bartman's answer by the 10 Feb meeting. Masiker mentioned that she needs to ask what the color choices are for the buildings. **OPEN ITEM.**

b. Locations and quantities of new smoke shelters: a base map was brought out and the LPC looked at where to place the new shelters.

2. Medical
3. POL/CE will share – placement at CE
4. LRS
5. Personnel Bldg
6. Hangar/AGE will share
7. Fuel/Fire Dept/Fabrication will share
8. Engine Shop
9. Avionics/ASA will share – at Avionics
10. OPS/BX will share
11. Vehicle MXS/Security Forces will share – at Security Forces

c. Need to discuss what to do with current smoke shacks on base since they are not authorized – postpone until next meeting. **OPEN ITEM.**

d. Need to determine a timeline of when these new smoke shacks would have to be purchased/delivered to base due to requirements of CBA because the union may file a grievance if a time is not set by March 15. **OPEN ITEM.**

e. Need to re-write LPC 3 regarding smoke shelters. **OPEN ITEM.**

3. New Business

A. New LPC Member: Dohrmann introduced Casey Cole as a new member of the LPC who will be representing Labor and replacing Matt Maynard.

B. Dohrmann stated that Reagan had put out an email looking for augmentees. He asked Giezie if the state employees were okay with them. Giezie said they were fine with the augmentee program as long as their jobs didn't get taken away by federal jobs.
