4. Old Business

A. Energy Update – Giezie gave an energy briefing. See [“energy slides”](#) for details. To date, we are using less than budgeted and less than the governor's goal, saving approximately \$60K this FY. According to TAG, we were the only wing in Ohio with a reduction in energy costs. **ALWAYS AN OPEN ITEM.**

B. Late Appraisals – Reviewed the [current list](#) provided by Czop. Reagan pointed out one discrepancy in the current list. **ALWAYS AN OPEN ITEM.**

C. LPC Review – Dailey - [LPC 3 \(Smoking Shelters\)](#) – Need UFR to pay for the shacks which will be purchased pre-made rather than built. Dailey would work the issue. **OPEN ITEM (MAY 07).**

D. Grievance/complaint – Leimenstoll. The case is reopened due to the individual involved was not available to answer any questions. Kynard & Nordhaus are to set up a meeting with the individual.

3. New Business

A. ORE/ORI Schedule (Fiscal Yr 2010) – Reviewed proposed schedules (#1 and #2). Upon LPC discussion/suggestions, Noel agreed to update next year’s schedule to provide flexibility with AT days so that individuals don’t have to use them all just for the ORE/ORI. Biddle described the “bookend” ORI schedule for July/August that will be mandated UTA & AT days (24 & 25 UTA, 5 AT days M-F 26 Jul – 30 Jul, 31 & Aug 1 UTA). Nordhaus seconded and all agreed.

- June ORE days may possibly be mandatory AT days depending on how things go in October and April. Still open for discussion.

- Issues were mentioned with covering leave and comp time during ORE/ORI.

- It was suggested to have EOC in place/operational on Thursday before WAR starts. Still open for discussion.

- Someone suggested having an LPC meeting on the first Tuesday after every ORE to discuss any issues that arose during the ORE. Everyone agreed. **Therefore, a special LPC meeting will be held after every ORE.**

B. The 180th LPC will reconvene for a regular meeting for Tuesday, 08 September 09 at 1330 hrs in the Wing Commander’s Conference Room.
