Procedure for Nomination and Selection

- 1. All nominations must be returned to SSG Nena Slate at nena.r.slate@mail.mil by 6 Febrary 2015 to be eligible for selection.
- 2. Use the attached nomination form. Nominations must be typed. Electronic submissions are preferred. Nominations must be submitted or approved by the Brigade/Wing/JFHQ level of command.
- 3. If available, please include appropriate documentation that may support the nomination.
- 4. The Ohio National Guard Selection Committee will review all nominations and select recipients for the award based upon the content of the nomination. The Ohio National Guard may choose not to present the award in any given year. The awards committee's selection is final.
- 5. Nominations that are unsuccessful this year may be revised and resubmitted in future years.
- 6. Past recipients of this award will not be considered again for this award.
- 7. Names of nominees remain confidential; only the names of selected award recipients are made public.
- 8. Nominators should retain a copy of the completed nomination package.
