Insuring Ohio Futures and Columbus State Community College are launching a pilot program for a new Foundations of Insurance Certificate. This two semester, six-course pilot program will prepare you for a Customer Service Representative (CSR) position in the insurance industry. CSR's are an entry-level position from which you can chart a career into a variety of different fields.

The CSR role is an integral part in the insurance industry. As a CSR you will be the first point of contact and interaction with policyholders. Your insight will determine an initial course of action for the customer and how the company or agency supports that individual.

The pilot program will launch in the Fall 2015. Forty-eight students will be enrolled in the program, which will be divided into two groups between the Columbus and Delaware campuses. Once you have successfully completed the program, there are six central Ohio insurance companies ready to guarantee interviews to students who excel in the program.
