WEEK IN REVIEW

F **OCTOBER 15, 1940:** The 37th Infantry Division is inducted into federal service by order of the President and sent to Camp Shelby, Miss. for 12 months of training.

OCTOBER 15, 1962: The 178th Wing, 179th Airlift Wing and 180th Fighter Wing are allotted to the Ohio Air National Guard and receive federal recognition as the 178th, 179th and 180th Tactical Fighter Groups in Springfield, Mansfield and Toledo.

37TH DIVISION CAMP SHELBY PENNANT

Souvenir pennants such as this one could be purchased by Soldiers at the post exchange. This blue felt pennant measures 8 inches wide by 10 inches long and contains the shoulder sleeve insignia of the 37th Division in the center. The yellow cord attached to the top permits the pennant to hang when displayed. Items like this could be displayed in Soldiers' tents or sent back home to friends and family.
