



WEEK IN REVIEW



MARCH 25, 1863: The first Medals of Honor were awarded to six Ohio Soldiers by Secretary of War Edwin Stanton. The Soldiers were members of Andrews' Raiders, a group of 22 men who volunteered to conduct a military raid in Northern Georgia.



MARCH 27, 1911: Support Company, 216th Engineer Battalion is organized in Cincinnati as Troop C, 1st Cavalry Squadron.



MARCH 29, 1954: Battery C, 1st Battalion, 174th Air Defense Artillery Regiment is organized as Howitzer Company, 3d Battalion, 107th Armored Cavalry.



MARCH 31, 1864: By authority of an act of the General Assembly of Ohio, the Ohio Militia is redesignated as the Ohio National Guard.
