

COLONEL THOMAS E. MOORE II

Assistant Adjutant General for Army, Ohio



Col. Thomas Moore is dual-hatted as the Ohio assistant adjutant general for Army and commander of the Ohio Army National Guard. In that capacity, he commands approximately 11,500 Soldiers and is responsible for all aspects of readiness for overseas deployments and homeland defense missions. Ohio Army National Guard assets include 44 facilities and over 23,000 acres of property with an annual budget of approximately \$340 million.

Prior to his current assignment, Moore served as the commander of the 174th Air Defense Artillery Brigade, deploying to the National Capital Region, and subsequently to Germany in support of the European Deterrence Initiative.

He holds a master's degree in strategic studies from the U.S. Army War College (Resident Course) and a Bachelor of Science in organizational communications from Ohio University. Moore is a member of several professional organizations including the Ohio National Guard Association (ONGA) and National Guard Association of the United States (NGAUS).
