DUTIES:

This position is located at the 123d Air Control Squadron. As an Air Battle Manager in the Ohio Air National Guard, you will be responsible for the command and control of air operations, integrating air, space, and cyber capabilities to ensure mission success. This includes directing airborne assets in real-time, managing airspace, and coordinating offensive and defensive actions in response to evolving threats. You will play a key role in planning and executing theater air operations, applying national defense strategy to develop effective battle plans. Furthermore, you will develop and lead realistic training exercises, evaluate unit training effectiveness, and create targeted, mission-specific training programs to maintain peak readiness. This position demands strong leadership, enabling you to foster teamwork, mentor fellow Airmen, and make critical decisions in a fast-paced, high-pressure environment.
