DUTIES:

Supervise and manage chapel operations, religious programs and resources in support of the Air Force mission. Chaplains develop and execute religious support plans and evaluate outcomes to ensure their effectiveness. Conduct worship services, liturgies, and rites. Provide counseling, pastoral care, unit engagement, religious education, morale programs, spiritual renewal, lay leadership programs, and humanitarian outreach opportunities. Represent faith and military communities in religious, patriotic, and civic events. Maintain liaison with civilian clergy and organizations to remain current in their specialty and areas of interest to Chaplain Corps programs. Advise leadership at all levels on spiritual, religious, ethical, moral, morale, and quality of life matters. Chaplains partner with religious affairs airmen to integrate into units and advise leaders on issues and the welfare of Airmen within their scope of responsibility. Chaplains also advise commanders of their responsibility to provide appropriate facilities or sites for worship, rites, and counseling. Maintain regular communication with endorsing officials and submit professional reports and records as required. Attend endorser-sponsored training and conference events as required by endorsing officials.
