SELECTED SOLDIERS ARE REQUIRED TO RELOCATE WITHIN 12 MONTHS OF SELECTION TO A RESONABLE COMMUNITING DISTANCE, WITHIN 50 MILES, OF THEIR ASSIGNED RECRUITING AREA.

APPLICANTS MUST CURRENTLY MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA FOR RECLASS TO CPMOS 79T:

- (1) A physical demands rating of Moderate (Gold).
 - (a) Must possess manual dexterity in both hands.
 - (b) Frequently reviews documents and records/correspondence.
 - (c) Frequently engages in verbal conversation.
 - (d) Frequently sits for extended periods of time.
- (e) Must not possess obviously distracting physical characteristics or mannerisms to include a shaving profile (waiver not authorized). Tattoos must be in compliance with AR 670-1
- (2) A physical profile of 132321. Soldiers possessing a 3 in Upper

Extremities must have prior MOS Administrative Retention Review (MAR2) clearance (waiver not authorized).

- (3) Qualifying scores.
- (a). Have a minimum general technical (GT) score of 110 (waivable to GT score of 100 or GT score of 95 with a skilled-technical score of 95).
- (b) A minimum OPAT scor<mark>e of</mark> Standing Long Jump (LJ) 0120 cm, seated Power Throw (PT) 0350 cm, Strength Dea<mark>dlif</mark>t (SD) 0120 lbs., and Interval Aerobic Run (IR) 0036 shuttles in Physical Demand Category in "Moderate" (Gold).
- (4) Meet selection criteria in National Guard Regulations 601-1, 600-200, 600-5, 600-10, applicable SMOMs, Army Regulations (AR) 601-280 and AR 135-18 as applicable.

****The AGR Office will not screen for OPAT compliance prior to accession. Units and Soldiers are responsible for ensuring that Soldiers reporting to school-meet standards as part of the ATRRS pre-screening criteria. Soldiers who do not qualify within the specified time will be released from the AGR Program for failure to meet education requirements as identified in AR 135-18***

GENERAL PREREQUISITES:

- 1. Must meet height and weight standards of AR 600-9.
- 2. Must be able to pass the current Army Combat Fitness Test.
- 3. Must not be under current suspension of favorable personnel actions.
- 4. Must be medically qualified under the provisions of Chapter 3 of AR 40-501 Retention Standards. Soldier must be deployable upon entering the AGR program.
- 5. Applicants who have voluntarily resigned from the AGR program are NOT eligible to reenter for one (1) year from date of separation. Soldiers who have voluntarily resigned from the AGR program in lieu of adverse personnel actions or have been involuntarily separated from the AGR program are not eligible to reenter the program.
- **6.** If any PULHES serial is a permanent 3 or 4 then a profile code of S, T, W or Y must be validated and documented on a current DA Form 3349 before AGR start date is determined.
- 7. Must meet the criteria of applicable regulations to obtain MOS/AOC IAW DA PAM 611-21.
- 8. Initial Entry Qualifications: Must meet entry requirements of AR 135-18, NGR 600-5, and AR 40-501 Chapter 3.
- 9. On-Board AGR Qualifications: Must continue to meet requirements of AR 135-18 and NGR 600-5.
- 10. All applicants: To apply, JPAS must reflect a favorable adjudication of T3 or National Agency Check with Local Agency and Credit Checks (NACLC). Must hold an Interim Secret or higher clearance for an Ohio National Guard Computer Network Account. Soldiers who have a clearance that has expired; has been suspended, denied, or revoked; or an investigation that was closed with a status of "unfavorable" or "no determination made" are not eligible to apply.
- 11. Current AGR Soldiers in stabilization (initial 18 month tour or EPS assignment) are not eligible to apply.

- 2. DA Form 5646, dated March 2017, filled out, signed and dated by Soldier within 30 days of submission date.
- 3. Medical Protection System (MEDPROS) Individual Medical Readiness (IMR). (PHA must be within 1 year of closing date).
- 4. Current copy of DA Form 705 (ACFT) with HT/WT verification. Last ACFT and HTWT on file must be PASSING within the last 6 months from the closing date. DA Form 5500-R or DA Form 5501-R (Body Fat Content Worksheet) must accompany DA Form 705 if screening table weight is not met. (Submit current PERMANANT PROFILE if an alternate event is performed.)
- 5. Security Verification Statement Memorandum annotating Soldier's current security clearance status (Available from MSC Security Manager). Memorandum must be dated within 30 days of submission date.
- Statement of all service performed. The following documents are accepted Form NGB 23b (RPAM) OR DD Form 1506 (Statement of Service).
- 7. Copy of Record Brief digitally or manually <u>signed by Soldier AND</u> digitally or manually <u>signed by unit.</u>

 Must currently meet line scores (verified on provided document). If ASVAB was recently taken please provide RED report with new line scores.
- 8. Applicant must submit evaluations (NCOER/OERs) all chronologically covering the past three years from the closing date (a minimum of three documents). Draft NCOER/OERs are not accepted. Letters of Recommendation can be submitted to cover any missing evaluations, or in addition to NCOERS/OER. Letters of Recommendation must be hand signed or have a verifiable digital signature (CAC certificate stamp). Letters of recommendation must be current within 6 months.
- Resume (Optional).
- Letter of Voluntary Reduction (if applicable).
- 11. Copy of front and back of current driver's license (must be clear and legible).
- 12. Must complete the OHARNG RRB Position Suitability Questionnaire (<u>HRR Form 600</u>, APR 2024), filled out, signed and dated by Soldier within 30 days of submission date.
